

# How to apply our products

The products should be applied onto cement and wood surfaces that have fissures. Before applying the product make sure that the existing cement surface is levelled and in good condition.



## Step 1 Sealer:

A primer is used to improve adhesion on smooth concrete and multiple surfaces.

## Step 3 Special Fix:

An adhesive tile with high flexibility, no cracks or fissures.

## Step 5 Eco-Porcelanic Microcement

In step 5, porcelanic microcement is applied. It's available in classic, concrete, transit, urban and other versions.

## Step 2 Elastic/Mesh

In step 2, two-stage, waterproof and very flexible cement plaster mortar is used. We use two coats, one before the mesh is applied and one thereafter.

## Step 4 Base

You need to apply at least two layers – this will help you make the surface perfectly flat.

## Step 6 Protection

Finally, an extremely thin protective layer is applied with the use of a translucent and transparent acrylic water-repellent.

Facades Porcelanic Microcement is a perfect choice for exterior wall application, due to its water and weather resistance.


Thanks to its high resistance and appealing texture, any facade can get a dynamic and classy look.

# Polished Plaster

*Polished plaster is a term for the finish of some plasters and for the description of new and updated forms of traditional Italian plaster finishes. The term covers a whole range of decorative plaster finishes— from the very highly polished Venetian plaster and Marmorino to the rugged look of textured polished plasters. Polished plaster itself tends to consist of slaked lime, marble dust, and/or marble chips, which give each plaster its distinctive look.*

*Polished plaster is mainly used internally, on walls and ceilings, to give a finish that looks like polished marble, travertine, or limestone. Such plasters are usually applied over a primer and basecoat base, from one to four layers.*
